In FS2 children will learn about and explore Catholic and Christian traditions, alongside traditions from other faith backgrounds, so they can develop an understanding and respect for all and the world around us.

Children will be introduced to new vocabulary and be taught through hearing, celebrating, believing and living. They will also be involved in Care of Creation and Chaplaincy teams.

Our Topic this term is...

Super Me, Super You!

Children will be able to talk about their feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry' or 'worried' and begin to understand how others might be feeling. Children will develop a positive sense of self and make sense of their own life story and family's history. Children will follow rules and understand why they are important.
