Children will visit our reading room where they will read for pleasure and chose a book to bring home.

Our amazing Reading Room



The children will join in with class reader time and will read 1:1 with an adult. They will discuss the books read in class. They will talk about the characters, setting and comment on the events. They will know that text is read from left to right and top to bottom.

Helping at Home Go on mini beast hunts in the garden or park. Look under leaves and logs together. Talk about what you find using simple words like names, colours, sizes and where they live. Read stories and information books about insects and small creatures. Remind your child to be gentle and kind to living things.

RE

In FS1 children will learn about and explore Catholic and Christian traditions, alongside traditions from other faith backgrounds, so they can develop an understanding and respect for all and the world around us.

Children will take part in activities that will involve playing, exploring, active learning, creating and thinking critically.

Our Topic this term is...*Creepy Crawlies*



The children will make close observations of minibeasts and their habitats. They will learn all about lifecycles, with a special focus on minibeasts such as caterpillars. The children will enjoy watching how minibeasts grow and change over time, developing their curiosity and understanding of the natural world.
