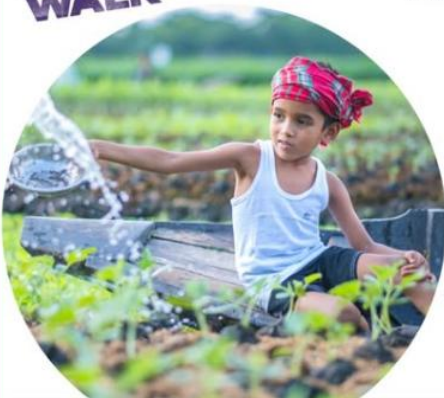

Punctuality



A polite reminder that the school begins at **8:55am** and all children must be in class ready to start their learning at this time. Any child who arrives after this time is classed as late and are at risk of not receiving their morning mark.

Please note that any child who arrives after 8:55am must be brought into school with an adult, who will need to sign them in. Gates open at 8:35am to allow a 20-minute dropping off window.

Please also ensure that all children have a school tie and black school shoes. Trainers (including black trainers) are not in line with school policy and are not allowed.
