Children will learn about space by exploring the sun, moon, stars and planets through stories, imaginative play, creative activities and discussions. They will develop curiosity about the world beyond Earth by learning about astronauts, rockets and space travel, as well as exploring concepts such as day and night, light and dark, and what can be seen in the sky.

Children will have opportunities to build vocabulary, ask questions, share ideas and express their learning through art, construction, role play and hands-on investigations.

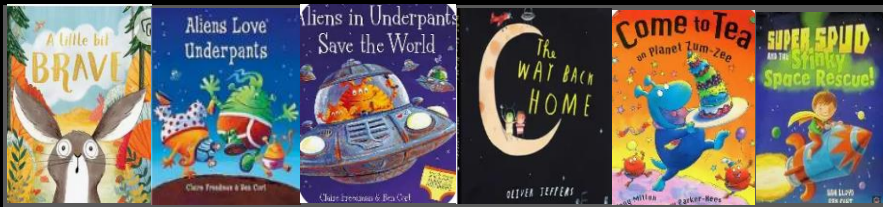
Our Topic this term is...

How You Can Help at Home

- Talk about the day and night sky
- Look at the moon and stars together
- Read space-themed stories
- encourage imaginative play with rockets and astronauts.

Children could draw planets, make junk-model rockets, count backwards for "blast off," or explore shapes and colours through space crafts. Watching short child-friendly videos about planets and astronauts can also help develop curiosity and vocabulary.
