



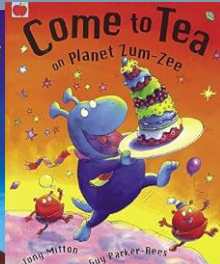
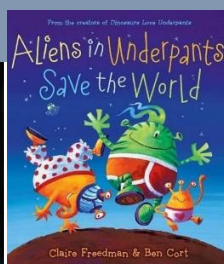
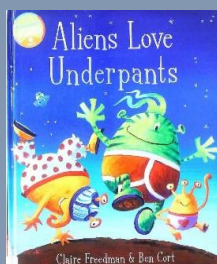

Our Topic this term is...
Out of this World

Children will enjoy sharing space-themed books, singing songs, and joining in with rhymes and poems all about space. They will learn about the wonders of the universe, including planets, stars, and astronauts, while exploring where space is and what can be found there. We will talk about similarities and differences between objects in space and on Earth, encouraging curiosity and wonder. Through these activities, children will develop an interest in the natural world beyond our planet and begin to understand how to care for and appreciate it.



How to help at home - Encourage your child to talk about space-themed stories, draw or create their own planets, rockets, aliens, or astronauts, and describe what they look like, where they are in space, and what adventures they have. Read space-themed books together and discuss the characters, settings, and new vocabulary.

Children will take part in activities that will involve playing, exploring, active learning, creating and thinking critically.

Your child will bring home a wordless book. Sharing wordless books is a terrific way to build important literacy skills including listening skills, vocabulary and comprehension. Please encourage your child to 'read' the book with their storytelling voice. Encourage more details using: Who? Where? When? Why? For a book with no words, you'll be surprised at all the talking you will do, and all the fun you will have.
