It is very important that all children are in school every day that week so they can complete the assessments with their class and feel fully prepared and supported.

Over the holidays, we would really appreciate children continuing to practise their times tables regularly. Even a few minutes each day can make a huge difference to their confidence and speed of recall.

Some useful ways to practise include:

- TT Rockstars
- Athletics
- Watching YouTube times tables songs and clips
- Quick-fire verbal questioning at home
- Writing multiplication facts on flashcards
- Playing times tables bingo or matching games
- Practising on Hit the Button
- Chanting multiplication facts while travelling or walking
- Using multiplication grids and timed challenges

Regular practice will help children feel much more confident and successful during the testing week.
