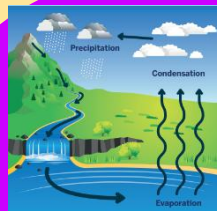
Significant People and Places

What are we learning about this half term?

English- We will write our own explanation text about Romans and write a journalist report about a Roman discovery!

Maths- We will learn how to multiply and divide by 10 and 100. We will also learn short multiplication methods and mental strategies for multiplication and division.
