## Our history topic for this half term is Stone, Bronze and Iron Age

1 million years ago



### Stone Age

- Palaeolithic: People are hunter-gathers. They move from place to place.
- Mesolithic: People use tools to help them.
- Neolithic: People farm, make pottery, and build large things, such as Skara Brae and Stonehenge.

4000 years ago



### Bronze Age

- In the Bronze Age, people learned how to make new objects from bronze and other metals.
- Some people became wealthy for the first time.
- There was conflict between groups of people because of wealth.

2000 years ago



### Iron Age

- In the Iron Age people started to use iron to make tools and weapons.
- They built hillforts to protect themselves.
- They traded with people in Europe.

## What are we learning about this half term?

**English-** We will write our own adventure narratives and a non-chronological report about the Stone Age. Can you research Stone Age facts and put them into sentences?

**Maths-** We will be learning about place value of 3 digit numbers. Can you order 2 digit numbers in ascending and descending order?



**Science-** We will learn that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. We will also learn about nutrition and what makes a balanced diet.



**RE-** Our topic is 'Creation and Covenant' and we will explore the historical, cultural and religious context of the biblical stories about the first story of Creation from the book of Genesis. Can you retell the creation story?
