RE: Continued teaching and learning in the event of a school closure

In the event of a school closure, teaching and learning will take place through 'LIVE' lessons on our remote learning platform 'Microsoft TEAMS'. This will begin from day two of any school closure. Children may also be signposted to access educational lessons from Oak National Academy – an online classroom.

If your child is likely to be using a mobile device (tablet, phone, etc.), then the best way to access Microsoft Teams is to download the TEAMS App from the App Store, Google Play, etc. If this is not possible, then Microsoft Teams can be accessed by the method on attached guide.

All children have a TEAMS sticker in the front of their reading record book. This will provide details of a username and password so that all children can log onto their accounts with ease. Please see each class page on our school website, which also provide specific details regarding remote learning, and includes a class timetable.

Please take the time to ensure that TEAMS is set up and ready to go, in the event of any school closure. Please see the school office if you have any questions or require any future support.
