### **Hear**

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will know:

- Jesus went back to his Father.
- He sent a special friend, the Holy Spirit, to look after us.
- Story of Pentecost (Simple Telling).
- The early Christian community (Acts 2:42-47).

### **Celebrate**

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will know:

### **Live**

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will know:

- The parish church. We gather with friends at church, especially on Sunday.
- The parish church and the parish family meet there to celebrate.
- CST Jesus knows that people can be happy with families and friends. He tells us that we can let these important people help us. He asks us to help them too. We need each other.
- We Are Called to Live as Family and Community.
- CST All people are God's children. That makes us brothers and sisters. We are connected to each other. It is as if everyone in the world held hands! We can be very different from each other, but we are still one family — God's family. Solidarity
