Intent	Our French curriculum aims to give children an awareness of other cultures and have the confidence and resilience to communicate in French for practical purposes, using both written and oral French. We aim to give pupils a foundation for language learning that encourages and enable them to apply their knowledge and skills – knowledge, skills and vocabulary that are built on from prior learning and repeated with increasing complexity.
