Intent

Art and Design is an integral part of a child's right to a broad and balanced curriculum. The teaching of Art and Design should build on children's prior learning and provide opportunities to be creative through curricular and cross-curricular topics. Children should develop and extend their creative skills with the opportunity for self-expression and a chance to build their resilience, confidence and critical thinking skills through working independently and collaboratively with others. Children should be introduced to a variety of artists both local and in the wider community to enhance their cultural capital and know about life beyond Stainforth- this enables children to reflect on their own history and heritage while understanding the richness of societies world-wide.

Children will learn to explore and experiment with mark-making to create textures. Children will learn to develop observational drawing. Children will learn to understand how to apply expressions to illustrate a character. Children will learn to develop illustrations to tell a story. 		<p>Painting and Mixed Media Life in Colour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will learn to develop knowledge of colour mixing. Children will learn to know how texture can be created with paint. Children will learn to use paint to explore texture and pattern. Children will learn to compose a collage, choosing and arranging materials for effect. Children will learn to evaluate and improve artwork. 		<p>Sculpture Clay Houses</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will learn to use my hands as a tool to shape clay. Children will learn to shape a pinch pot and join clay shapes as decoration. Children will learn to use impressing and joining techniques to decorate a clay tile. Children will learn to use drawing to plan the features of a 3D model. Children will learn to make a 3D clay tile from a drawn design.

<p>Year 4</p>	<p>Drawing Power Prints</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will learn to draw using tone to create a 3D effect. • Children will learn to explore proportion and tone when drawing. • Children will learn to plan a composition for a mixed-media drawing. • Children will learn to use shading techniques to create pattern and contrast. • Children will learn to work collaboratively to develop drawings into prints. 		<p>Painting and Mixed Media Light and Dark</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will learn to investigate different ways of applying paint and mix tints and shades of a colour. • Children will learn to use tints and shades to give a three-dimensional effect when painting. • Children will learn to explore how paint can create very different effects. • Children will learn to consider proportion and composition when planning a still-life painting. • Children will learn to apply knowledge of colour mixing and painting techniques to create a finished piece. 		<p>Sculpture Mega Materials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will learn to develop ideas for 3D work through drawing and visualisation in 2D. • Children will learn to use more complex techniques to shape materials. • Children will learn to explore how shapes can be formed and joined in wire. • Children will learn to consider the effect of how sculpture is displayed. • Children will learn to choose and join a variety of materials to make sculpture.
<p>Year 5</p>	<p>Drawing Space Race</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will learn to explore the purpose and effect of imagery. • Children will learn to understand and explore decision making in creative processes. • Children will learn to develop drawn ideas through printmaking. • Children will learn to test and develop ideas using sketchbooks. • Children will learn to apply an understanding of drawing processes to revisit and improve ideas. 		<p>Sculpture Interactive Installations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will learn to identify and compare features of art installations. • Children will learn to investigate the effect of space and scale when creating 3D art. • Children will learn to problem-solve when constructing 3D artworks. • Children will learn to plan an installation that communicates an idea. • Children will learn to apply their knowledge of installation art and develop ideas into a finished piece. 		<p>Painting and Mixed Media Portraits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will learn to explore how a drawing can be developed. • Children will learn to combine materials for effect. • Children will learn to identify the features of self-portraits. • Children will learn to develop ideas towards an outcome by experimenting with materials and techniques. • Children will learn to apply knowledge and skills to create a mixed media self-portrait.
