Cyber bullying – Bullying online



What is 'cyber bullying' ?

Cyber bullying is when you are constantly being mean to someone or several people online.

What does this look like?

- Calling someone bad names.
- Picking on someone on a game.
- Using bad language towards someone.

Conflict toolkit: What do I do if I am being cyber bullied?



Tell a trusted adult



Do not play with that person anymore



Stay kind and do not be horrible back

It is easier to bully people online because the bully can hide behind technology (for example on a computer, ipad or xbox.)

Bullies may be going through a hard time.



Why do people bully others online?



Sometimes bullies think it is a joke and that they are cool but this upsets other people.

So... what should I do if a disagree with someone?

Be kind and speak to an adult about it.

Make friends and try to make up if you fall out.

Remember to respect other beliefs if you both give your opinion.

Understand that people can have different views and opinions.

What to do if you are being bullied

Tell a trusted adult- like your parent or teacher.

Do not respond to bullies.

Speak out if you or someone you know is being bullied.



How to put a stop to bullying and cyber bullying

Be kind to one another.

Play online safely and be kind to people you play with.

Be respectful to everyone even if you do not agree with what they say.

Understand that everyone is allowed to have different opinions.
