



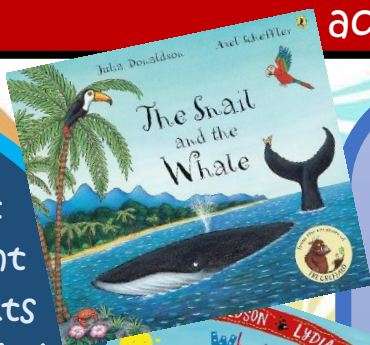
Year 1 Classroom News!
